

How to Participate in the Erasmus Mundus Community

in 7 Easy Steps

1 Create an eulogin or login with your eulogin account

- Visit the Erasmus Networks Platform.
- Remember to read the Privacy Statement which informs you how your personal data is processed and protected.

This step is necessary to check your eligibility before joining the organization/groups

- Edit your profile by clicking "edit profile".
- Start filling out your profile information, including a profile picture and bio, to help others get to know you better. It is important to fill out everything and include the name and acronym of your Erasmus Mundus project so that your request to join the community can be accepted.

3 Go to the homepage of the community

- Request to join as a representative and follow the community.
- When the request is approved, you are officially part of the community.

Find groups & Join

- Explore the platform to find groups that match your interests or objectives. Once you find a group that interests you, click on it to access more information.
- Look for a "Join" or "Request to Join" button and click it.
- Some groups may be open to anyone, while others might require approval from a moderator.

5 Read the group guidelines

- Most groups have rules and guidelines that members are expected to follow.

Introduce yourself & participate

- After joining a group, it's good practice to introduce yourself. Share a brief bio or a post explaining your interests and why you joined the group.
- Engage in discussions, ask questions, and contribute to the group's conversations.
- Remember to be respectful and constructive in your interactions.

7 Use Notifications Wisely

- Configure your notification settings to receive updates that matter to you.
