



## What is Erasmus+ 2021-2027?



EU's commitment to fostering education, training, youth, and sports collaboration

Key Action 1 (KA1): <u>Learning</u> Mobility for individuals, including students, staff, and volunteers

**Key Action 2 (KA2)**: <u>Cooperation</u> for Innovation and Exchange of Good Practices, between organizations, institutions, and stakeholders

**Key Action 3 (KA3)**: Support for <u>Policy Development</u> through policy cooperation and innovation in education, training, and youth

Jean Monnet Actions: Focused on promoting excellence in teaching and research in the field of <u>European Union</u> <u>studies</u>.



## Opportunities for people and institutions from Thailand

#### International Credit Mobility (ICM)

- HEIs: Find a partner institution in Europe & aim for the mobility agreement
- Individuals: Check with your home institution & apply for the mobility activities

#### Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters (EMJM)

- Individuals: Apply directly to the consortium website
- HEIs: Take part in the degree offering consortium

• HEIs: Assess your institution needs and potential & find a partner institution for forming the alliance, learn from experienced HEIs for best practices sharing

- Networking and Best Practices: gain exposure to diverse perspectives, leading to the adoption of effective strategies and solutions.
- **Promoting Inclusivity and Diversity**: foster a more inclusive and diverse educational environment in Thailand, aligning with global best practices
- **Global Competitiveness**: enhance global competitiveness in education, research, and innovation, by exposing to international standards and practices can elevate the quality of Thai institutions
