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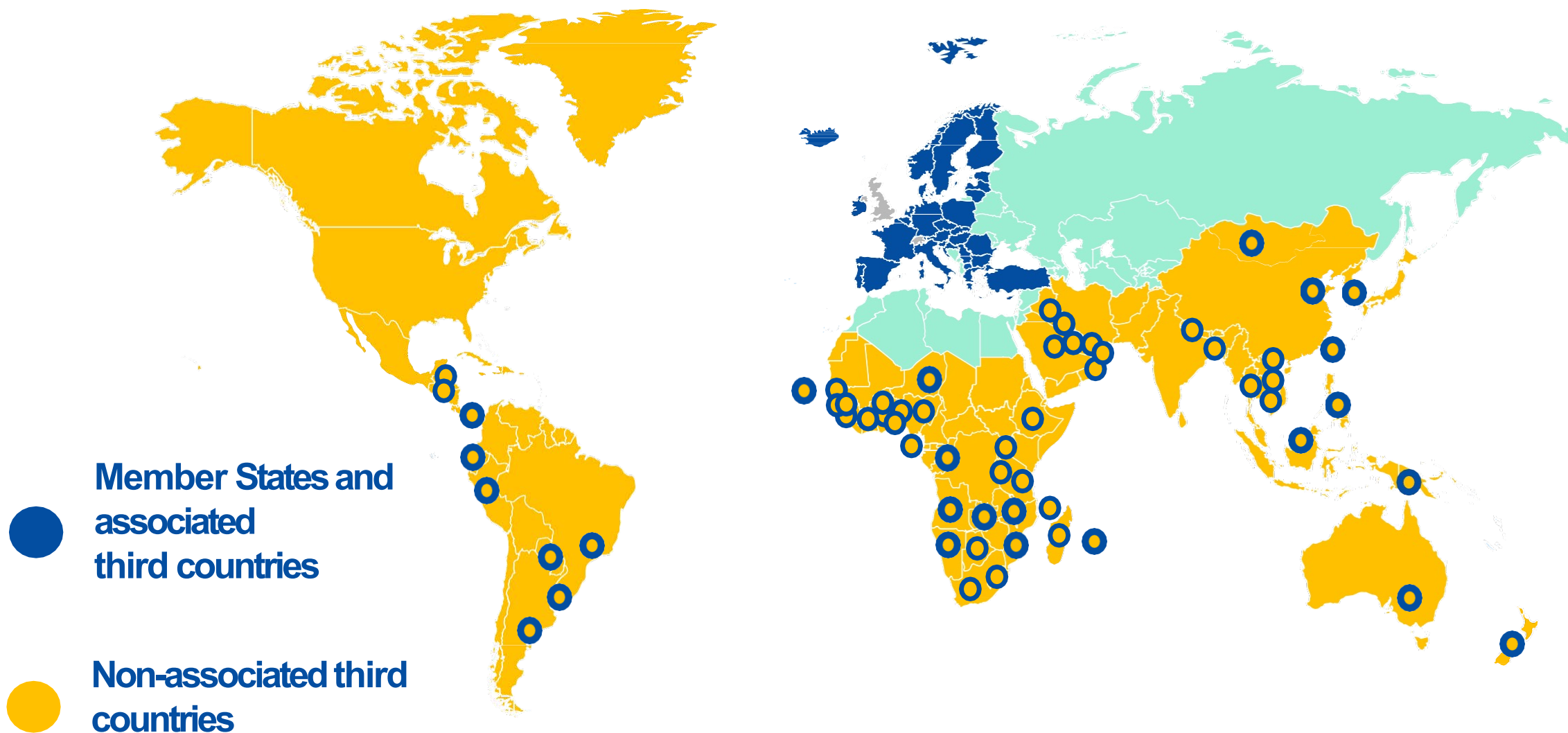


What is Erasmus+?

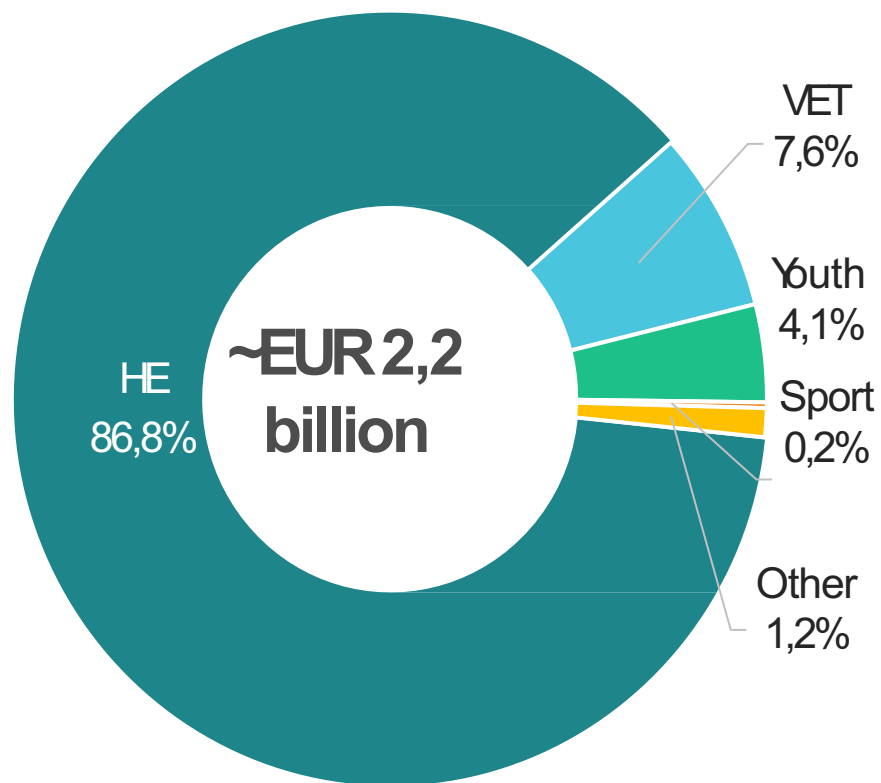

International dimension of Erasmus+

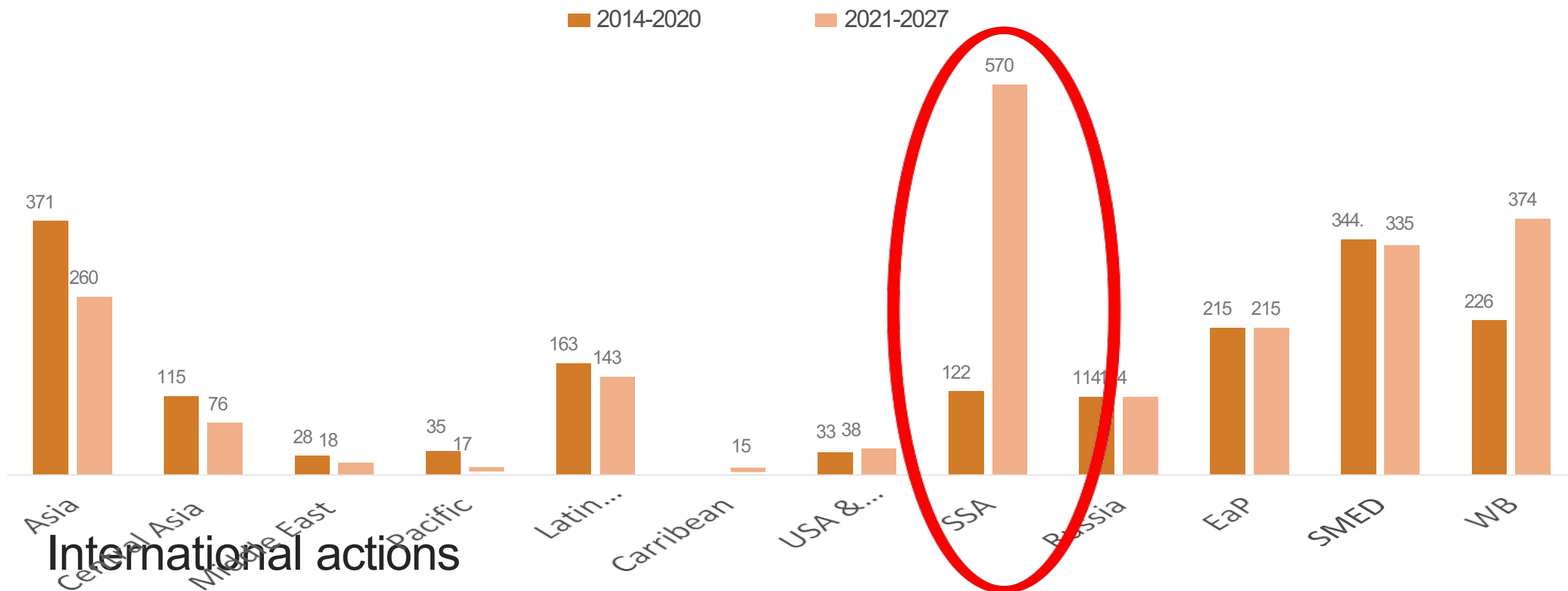


International actions

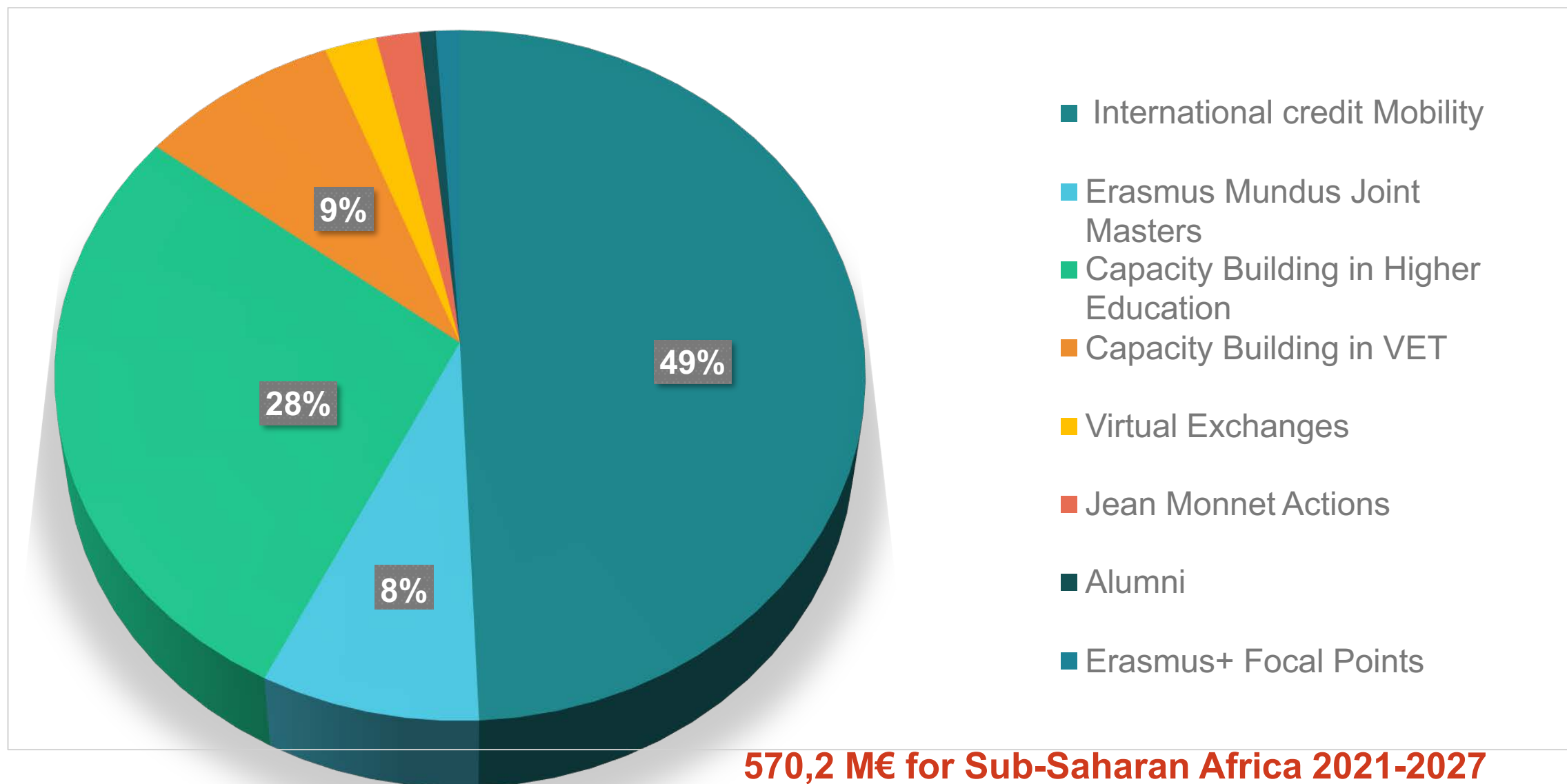

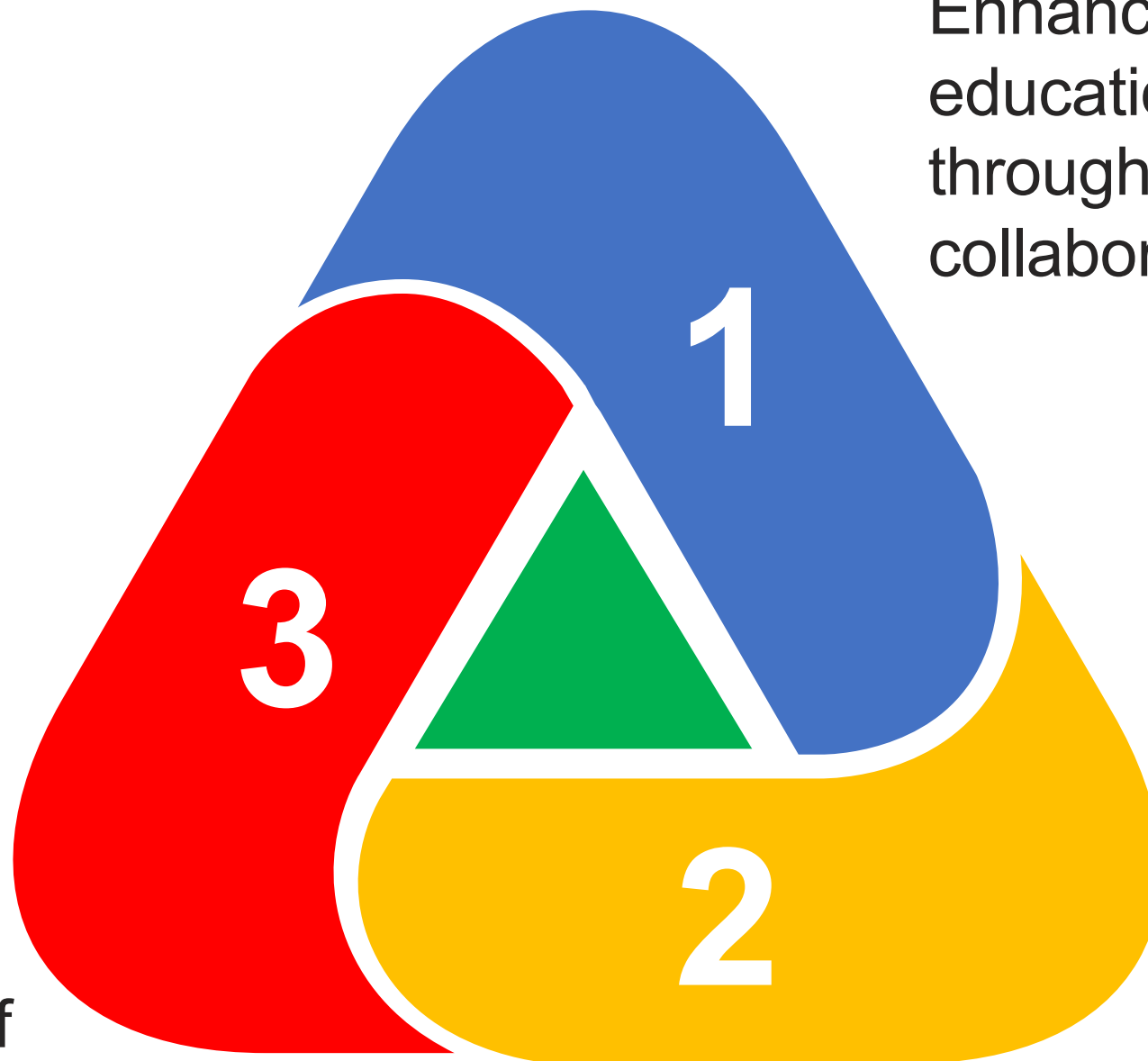

Erasmus Plus for Mauritius

International Credit Mobility

This allows students to study in a foreign university for 2 -12 months and obtain credits which are then recognised at the sending institution as part of their degree.

The mobility can be from 5-30 days, if part of blended mobility (a combination of physical mobility with a virtual component). Traineeships are also possible.

Staff mobility can be for 5-60 days.

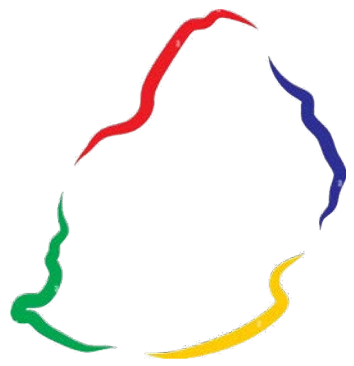
Capacity Building for Higher Education (CBHE)

- Aimed at modernising and reforming higher education institutions, developing new curricula, improving governance, and building relationships between higher education and enterprises.
- Can also be used to tackle policy for higher education reform, in cooperation with national authorities.
- Over 25% of the annual global budget for CBHE projects is for sub-Saharan Africa.
