





# Geographical scope of Erasmus Mundus



## EMJM Set-up



**Grant Agreement of 74 months** independently from the length of the master



Commitment to enrol a certain number of students per project



At least 4 master editions lasting 1 to 2 academic years (60, 90 or 120 ECTS)



At least 2 study periods in 2 countries (of which at least one in an EU MS or a 3<sup>rd</sup> country associated to the Programme, both different from the country of residence of students)




**Start of the 1st edition** no later than the academic year following the year of project selection




Geographical balance of students: ≤10% of total scholarships per project awarded to students of the same nationality (does not apply to additional scholarships for targeted regions)



# Student scholarships

- Full Scholarship to cover subsistence, installation and travel
- A single unit cost per scholarship holder: €1 400 per month (min. 1 academic year max. 24 months)
  - => max. amount per student: 33 600 euro
- Erasmus Mundus Scholarship holders benefit from a fee waiver and an insurance coverage

## Individual needs (top-up mechanism)

Enrolled students (with or without scholarship) with disabilities (e.g. long term physical, mental intellectual or sensory impairments) can get additional support to cover costs such as those related to the acquisition of special items or services (e.g. assistance by third persons, adaptation of work environment, additional travel/transportation costs)

Contribution **based on individual needs** of students:

10 different unit costs varying between €3 000 – €60 000

# Rationale behind lot EMDM

- Fill the gap of the Erasmus Mundus Action by supporting the **development** of new joint master programmes
- Diversify the offer of Joint Master Programmes and encourage new academic cooperation by involving Erasmus Mundus under-represented EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme, and/or institutions from these countries, and/or thematic areas





### Who can apply?

The applicants must be legal entities:

- -Higher education institutions (HEIs)
- -Established in an EU Member State or third country associated to the Program or in an eligible third country not associated to the Program.

### **Duration of the project**

Projects should normally last 15 months (extensions are possible, if duly justified and through an amendment).

The lump sum is 55,000 EUR per project


# 3. Recommendations

2. There must exist institutional support.

3. Possible allies should be examined carefully before contacting them.


4. Don't be disappointed if they say no... sometimes it is for better.



5. Organize your ideas clearly in the proposal (conductive thread is important).

6. Make sure you align specific objectives with activities.
