Work Package 1

Benchmarking, Strategy and Training

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Achievements

- Review of current policies at Pakistani Partners.
- Developing and delivering a training programme
- Successful delivery of the training programme (albeit virtually!) in March 2021
 - **18 individuals trained**
- Developing strategies for internationalization
 - **All 4 Pk partners developed strategies vetted by respective universities**
- Twinning of Partner Countries and EU Higher Education Institutions for mentoring
 - 87.5% complete satisfaction of the twinning partnerships



Work Package 2

*Training Workshops - CPD for
All Staff*

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Achievements

- First half of train the trainers CPD
 - Implementation of the Internationalisation Strategy – December 2021
 - High Quality Partnerships – March 2022
 - Academic Recognition and Recognition of Staff – June 2022
 - External Funding – November 2022
- **20+ participants in each session!!**



Achievements

- Second phase of CPD - 04 cascade trainings at PK partner institutions which were co-designed and co-delivered in a blended mode
 - May 2023 – Internationalization Strategies
 - July 2023 – International Partnerships
 - September 2023 - Academic recognition and Recognition of Staff
 - October 2023 – External funding
- **Total: 207**



Work Package 3

Online Learning Programme

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Achievements

- Online course on Internationalisation developed <https://binternational.usal.es/binternational/>
- Topics covered are:
 - Mobilities
 - Recognition process
 - Internationalising the institution considering international perspectives (strategic plan)
 - Research: Finding partners, managing partnerships and sourcing funding
- **630 people have completed the online modules** (800+ have registered)

International Campus*

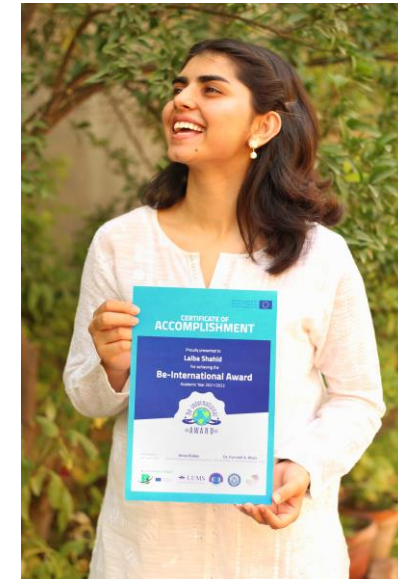
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Achievements

- Events to promote internationalization on campus
- **+1800 participants**
- **77 external speakers** (Erasmus Delegates, DAAD, MEXT, Alumni, Junior Diplomats, USEFP, etc.)
- To recognise skills development - Be International Award Centre for Internationalisation's employability Award that recognizes extra-curricular activities which focuses on students' self-development.

- From November 2021 to date:
- Number of attendees across all Centres = **2277**.
- Number of activities hosted: **90, with 2361 participants**.

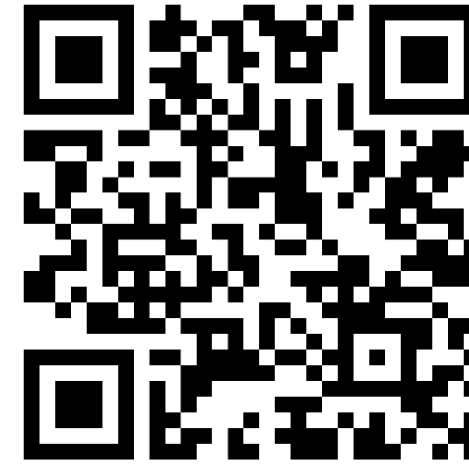
