

- ✓ Producing, developing and disseminating knowledge and interaction (Local & International).




SQU Internationalization

• Erasmus Mundus "EM SECRET" 2012-2018

EU: City University of London (**England**), Frederick University (**Cyprus**), Technische Universität Dresden (**Germany**), Magna Graecia University of Catanzaro (**Italy**), Technische Universiteit Eindhoven (**Netherlands**) and University of Deusto (**Spain**)

GCC: University of Bahrain (Bahrain), Kuwait University (Kuwait), Sultan Qaboos University (Oman) and United Arab Emirates University (UAE).

• EU = **30%**, GCC = **70%**.

• Schemes covered: Staff Mobility, Master Scholarships, PhD Scholarships & Post-Doctorate Scholarships.


- Based on the Final Report (GAA number: 2012-5538):

(11) SQU Staff = (7) Staff Mobility + (4) Master & PhD

- **✓** Some Highlights from the Final Report:
- "SQU took on the position of the leading institution in GCC and brought to the scheme more that it was expected."
- "While other institutions in the region put minimum effort, SQU used this opportunity as efficiently as they could. They have provided for their students and staff training abroad and on top of it raised their international profile across EU not only as an institution but also as a country."
