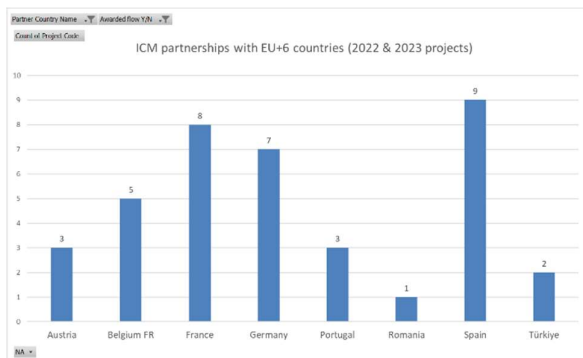


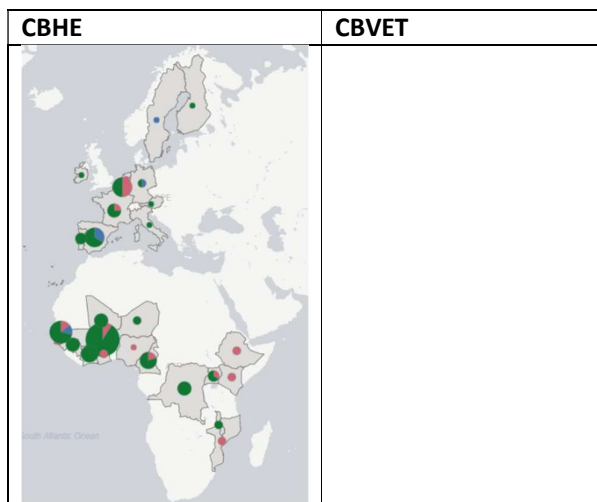

Our priorities for education

N°1 priority for education

Accommodation capacities at each university; The re-opening of schools in insecure areas and the return of teachers to these schools. The policy of decentralizing universities and granting access to university to every baccalaureate holder in Burkina Faso has resulted in a shortage of classrooms and lecture theatres. Solving the problem of classrooms can solve the problem of delayed teaching.

N°2 priority for education

Increased opportunities in agriculture and mining engineering. The government of Burkina Faso is committed to developing food self-sufficiency. To achieve this, it is necessary to encourage the opening of new branches in agriculture, so that graduating students can become promoters themselves. The same goes for mining engineering. These two sectors contribute to the country's economy.

N°3 priority for education

Funding research in higher education is a top priority, as its results feed into teaching. The number of lecturers and researchers is increasing, and there are more and more innovative themes, but there isn't enough funding to conduct this research. The promotion of technical and vocational education and training needs to be funded as a priority. The same applies to distance learning.
