




Our priorities for education

N°1 priority for education

Access to quality education: Improving access to education for all children, particularly in marginalized and rural areas, remains a crucial priority. In Burundi, many schools lack proper infrastructure including classrooms, libraries, and other essential facilities. This posed challenges to providing a conducive learning environment.

N°2 priority for education

Teacher Training and Professional Development:
Providing teachers with ongoing training
opportunities, resources, and recognition is crucial.
Despite a constrained economic development,
Burundi has chosen to invest in its youth and its
future. For that reason, efforts have been made in
the domain of teacher training and professional
development to enhance sustainable development.
