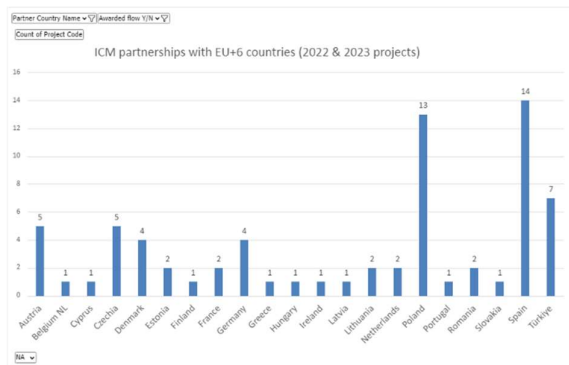

N°1 priority for education

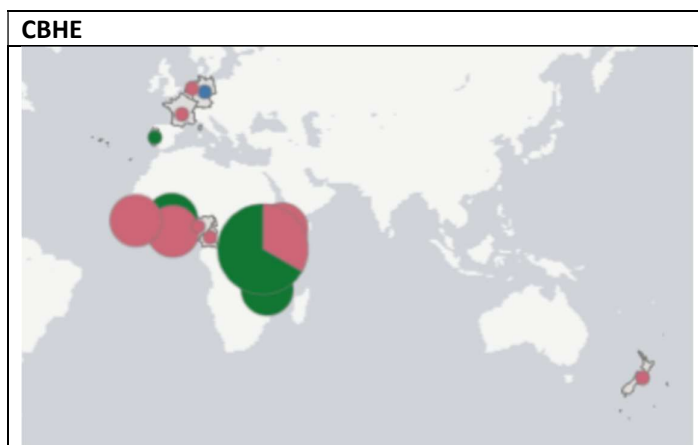
N°2 priority for education
