STUDENTS DO NOT STUDY AT ALL INSTITUTIONS, BUT THEY RECEIVE A DIPLOMA SIGNED BY ALL INSTITUTIONS


- Accreditation of a QP course at each institution and recognition of the equivalence of all courses.
- Definition of the credit ranges to be earned in each scientific area
- All students are enrolled in all partner institution and the computer system that manages the careers is that of UNIFE (ESSE3).

THERE IS NO SINGLE, CLEAR PROCEDURE FOR ISSUING A JOINT DEGREE ACROSS ALL INSTITUTIONS/COUNTRIES.

 Proposal prepared by the teaching staff but then carried forward primarily through exchanges between the administrations. THE PROCEDURE IS VERY LENGTHY

- The diplomas must be signed in original by all the rectors.
- Issuance of 'provisional' certificates



IMQP JOINT DEGREE

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Result

ACCREDITATION

- Accreditation at the individual sites of the Master's in Quaternary and Prehistory, with mention of its joint nature and the fact that the joint diploma is issued by UNIFE.
- Accreditation (ANVUR) of the joint master's program at UNIFE (Coordinating institution)
- With the introduction of UP Diliman in 2024 as partner, the joint program is also in the process of accreditation in the Philippines. This is to explore the potential possibility of issuing a joint degree with them as well.



JOINT DS "EVOLUTION"

How to communicate the joint nature of the course?

The courses attended were listed all together, regardless of the institution where they were completed. The joint aspects could only be inferred from the general description of the master's program

STAGE 1

The courses were listed in groups, specifying the institution where they were validated. The joint courses were not sufficiently highlighted. Addition of a specific section regarding the joint courses, with details on the involvement of faculty from all partner institutions.

LEGAL BARRIERS

The apostille is requested especially by students from South America, but it can only be issued at the police headquarters in Ferrara, because for the legalization of the diploma signatures, a list of authorized signatories must be submitted in advance. APOSTILLA

It has not yet been possible to proceed with the deposit of the electronic signatures of the rectors of the partner universities at UNIFE, resulting in an extension of the time required for the signature to be issued. DIGITAL SIGNATURE

European students (when they do not continue to a PhD) sometimes also request a multiple degree because some employers do not recognize the added value of a joint degree KNOWLEDGE ABOUT JOINT DEGREES


