This national policy review provides a detailed analysis of Paraguay's educational policies and their alignment with the Erasmus+ programme. It offers official, first-hand information into the country's engagement with Erasmus+ from 2021 to 2024, highlighting opportunities for improvement and identifying strategies to enhance integration and outcomes. Prepared and submitted by the Erasmus+ National Focal Point, this review contributes to ongoing efforts to strengthen international cooperation and to maximise the benefits of the Erasmus+ programme in Paraguay.

Regional Academic Mobility Programme for Accredited Degrees (MARCA)

It is a programme for degree courses accredited by the MERCOSUR Regional Accreditation System that seeks to strengthen these courses, fostering the internationalisation of higher education in the region and fulfilling the central objective of regional integration.

Don Carlos Antonio López Scholarship Programme (BECAL)

BECAL is an academic excellence programme and an emblem of the Paraguayan Government. It is aimed at university graduates who want to pursue postgraduate studies abroad. It seeks to strengthen R&I and education by improving Paraguay's supply of advanced human capital. It is financed jointly with FEEI, IDB, and the Ministry of Economy and has international agreements or alliances with universities and agencies.

The BECAL Programme offers scholarships for postgraduate studies (masters, doctorates, post-doctorates) abroad. Postgraduate scholarships are offered in two modalities:

- Self-managed: the candidate must apply for admission to foreign universities following the specifications of the international rankings for the different programmes
- Assisted mode: the admission process to the university abroad is done through specialised agencies with which BECAL has signed agreements.

Agreement on the Recognition of Higher Education Degrees in MERCOSUR

The purpose of the Agreement is to recognise degree qualifications that are officially valid in the country where they were issued, provided they meet the Agreement's requirements. In Paraguay, the Agreement is being reviewed by the following Senate commissions: a) Legislation, Codification, Justice, and Labor; b) Foreign Affairs and International Affairs; and c) Culture and Education.

Plan for the Internationalisation of Higher Education

In the context of the 2018-2024 Education Action Plan, efforts were made to design the plan using a dialogical approach. This approach helped gather information about Paraguay's internal needs and the importance of cooperating internationally. The goal is to create a supportive and collaborative policy for the internationalisation of higher education in Paraguay. This will help the country improve its ability to offer inclusive and high-quality education. The plan is currently under review and will be presented soon.

Adjustment of the processes of recognition and recognition of foreign degrees is under discussion

To optimise the process, redesigning the processes of recognition and recognition of higher education degrees obtained abroad is under discussion.

National Agency for the Evaluation and Accreditation of Higher Education (ANEAES)

It is the institution responsible for evaluating and accrediting the quality of higher education in Paraguay for its continuous improvement.
