





SHINE is a Capacity Building project funded by the EU Commission that seeks to drive the green transition and enhance energy access in Africa. A European-African consortium, involving VET providers and stakeholders from education, industry, and public authorities, is collaboratively redesigning a market-oriented VET program focused on solar panel technology.

The goal is to create an impactful program equipping young Africans with the skills for sustainable community development.
